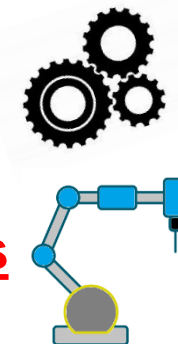
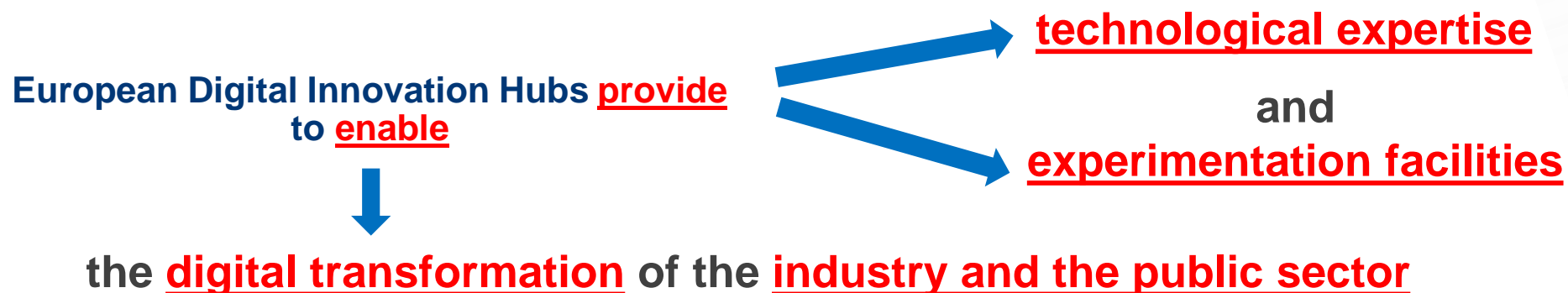

Offer support for digital transformation which is adapted to local needs, based on a specialisation

Build **regional ecosystems** of users and suppliers, strengthening local innovation environment

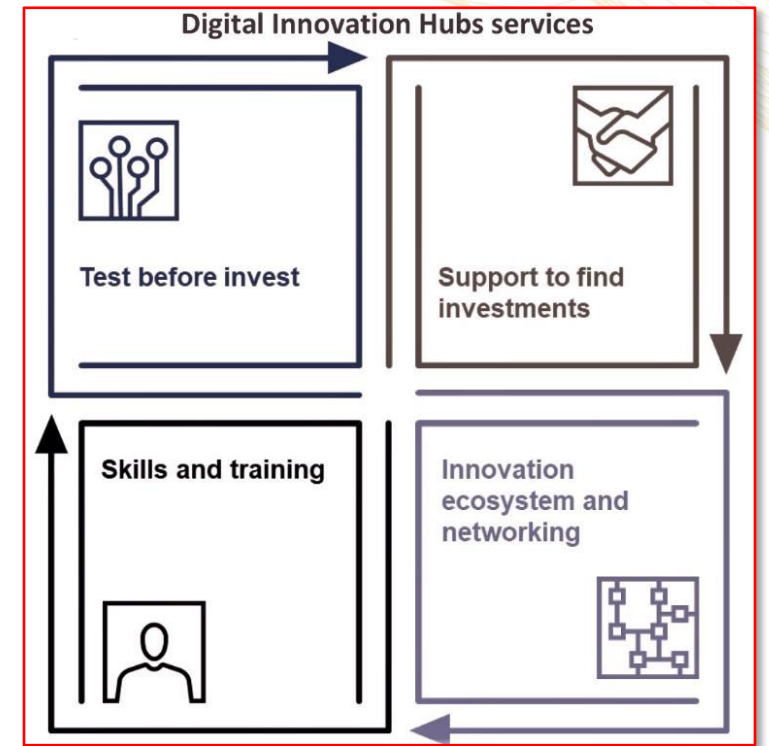
Connect to the whole of Europe through the network:

- Share best practices with other hubs

- Connect local SMEs to SMEs outside the region, building new value chains in Europe

- Seek synergies with innovators

- Disseminate digital capacities of Digital Europe Programme to local community



EDIH contribute to the country strategy for digitalisation

Given the importance of Artificial Intelligence and its wide applicability in all sectors, the European Commission expects that at least one of the hubs designated in each country will have expertise in AI

The network of European Digital Innovation Hubs

The network today includes **EU countries + 3 associated countries** (Norway, Iceland and Lichtenstein)

Other countries have signed an association agreement or are in the process of signing/ratifying it.

To be eligible the country has to be associated to DEP before the signature of the Grant Agreement (requested applicability from 01 January 2023 – budget from 2021-2023)

The Grant Agreement must be signed before end of 2024 (budget from 2021-2023)

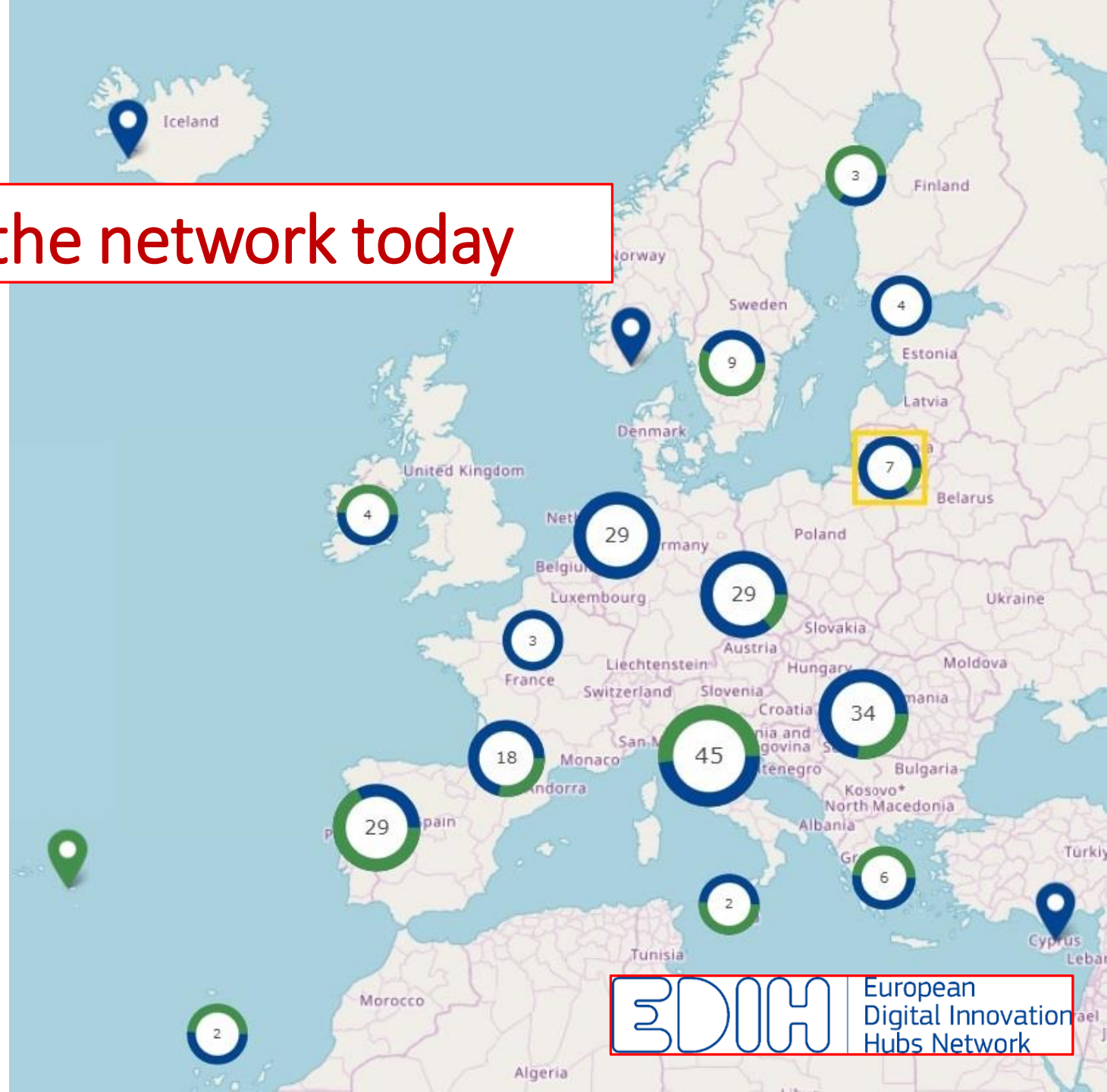

The structure of an EDIH

An EDIH can be organised in different ways:

- One single entity or a small consortium
- A new consortium or a pre-existing hub

Coordinator: non-profit foundation

Partners: industry association, universities, private companies, chamber of commerce, municipality

Tuscany X.0

Coordinator: network of local companies

Partners: industry association, universities, private companies, research institution, non-profit foundation

ENTIRE

Coordinator: research institute

Partners: university, vocational training institution

Let's be as fast as possible, but not faster

Proposal 5 1 M€ 50% 0,5 M€ GA with DEP

Budget must be allocated (Grant signed) by the end of 2024

EDIH co-funding

- Up to 50% funded through Digital Europe Programme
- Countries will co-fund the selected EDIHs in their territory by providing matching funding (national funds, private sources, income generated by the project, contributions from partners)
- In the proposal (Application Form, Part B, Section 1.4 Financial obstacles) – the proposers have to describe how the project will be co-funded

EDIH will receive around 65% (of the 50% from DEP) as pre-financing, at the start of the project

The co-fund from the country does not need necessarily to be available at the start of the project – to be decided by the country/EDIH

From the Workprogramme text:

December 2023

The selection of the EDIHs will follow a two-step process: first, an Expression of Interest (see topic 1.1) will request Member States to designate potential EDIHs through a national process, and secondly the European Commission will launch two restricted calls (see topic 1.2) for proposals in which only designated potential EDIHs are eligible to participate.

June 2024

EDIH are supposed to be a tool to implement the country digitalisation strategy, so experts will evaluate the proposals on the basis of standard criteria (relevance, implementation, impact) but also on the basis of the coherence with the specific digitalisation strategy of the country.

We will ask Associated Countries to name a country expert for the evaluation

Selection process for the EDIHs

Preparing a grant agreement is time-consuming:

- Registering all participants in the EC database (takes time!)
- Verifying their financial viability (need to provide financial documents!)
- Address recommendations from evaluators (e.g. to fix mistakes)

**Budget must be allocated (Grant signed)
by the end of 2024**
