1. Objectives of the session

- Investigating possible impacts of the AI Act implementation on the public sector.
- Raising awareness around the AI TEF ecosystem and the possible synergies with EDIHs.
- Sharing best practices about EDIHs' support to the public sector, including in activities that could be relevant for the AI Act (i.e. sandbox, testing, compliance).
- Discussing the WG's priorities for the next year.

2. Description

The workshop will serve to investigate the impact of the AI in the public sector, including in relation to the implementation of the AI Act, share best practices on the provision of AI services to the public sector as well as identify priorities for the work of the AI4PA WG for 2025.

Following the introduction by DG DIGIT, representatives of the AI Office and JRC will outline the most recent analysis about the impact of AI in the public sector, including in relation to the AI Act. The workshop will then focus on the role of AI Testing and Experimentation Facilities (TEFs) and the potential synergies with EDIH.

EDIHs will be able to share success stories and best practices on the provision of AI-related services to the public sector. To the extent possible, presentations will touch upon the contribution of EDIH to the implementation of the AI Act as well as challenges faced. The final part of the session will be dedicated to setting out the Working Group's priorities for the upcoming year.
